

## You Can Help Local Students Launch Their Future

Two of every three new jobs created in Florida by 2025 will require education or training beyond high school.

Fast-track technical certificate programs can launch students into many high-demand careers.

For other eligible students, we have an opportunity to get them on a two- or four-year post-secondary path with a remarkable, highly flexible scholarship opportunity that covers a full-year of Florida college tuition for a fraction of the value.

## **DETAILS:**

- Each Jump Start scholarship requires contributions totaling \$3,000, which are matched at 3 to 1.
- For students from low-income families, these scholarships pay for about \$9,000 in Florida college tuition over five years (30-credits or 1 year of full-time study).
- Donors can use pre-tax dollars as part of a Required Minimum Distribution (RMD), or donations can be a charitable contribution from your taxable 2024 income.
- Some college credit has a nice payoff in Florida! In 2022, when compared to high school grads, college-credit certificate holders in FL had a \$21,084 annual earnings advantage!
- Locally, several College-Credit-Certificate programs lead to associate degrees and high-skill wages.
